"A psychologist becomes the bridge between a boarding student's heart and their sense of belonging, creating a home away from home through understanding, support, and care."The school psychologist engages with students referred for support by conducting comprehensive evaluations based on behavioral observations, presenting concerns, academic performance, and familial dynamics. The primary goal is to differentiate between transient behavioral responses to external stressors and more persistent psychological challenges. Following this preliminary assessment, students may be referred for detailed psychometric evaluations or psychiatric consultations with qualified professionals or government-recognized institutions, ensuring compliance with CBSE guidelines for further certification processes. In addition to individual assessments, the psychologist adopts a holistic approach to understanding the developmental trajectories of all students, acknowledging the critical significance of the formative years. During this period, children encounter a spectrum of experiences, both positive and adverse, which influence their emotional well-being. Recognizing the need for a trusted confidant, the psychologist fosters a therapeutic rapport with students, providing a safe and confidential environment for them to process their emotions and experiences. By addressing interpersonal, familial, and academic influences on the students' psychological health, the psychologist aims to mitigate crisis and promote resilience. This approach is designed to support students in becoming emotionally well-regulated, physically healthy, and socially responsible individuals capable of navigating life's challenges effectively. The psychologist routinely conducts observational visits to the hostel environment to ensure the psychosocial well-being of the students and to assess the overall atmosphere for its conduciveness to positive mental health. These visits aim to identify potential stressors or maladaptive dynamics that could affect the students' emotional and psychological state, ensuring that the hostel environment mirrors a supportive and nurturing home-like setting. Additionally, structured therapeutic interventions, including home-like counseling sessions, are scheduled at regular intervals, typically every seven days. These sessions provide a safe and consistent platform for students to express their emotions, discuss challenges, and build coping mechanisms. Such regular interactions are critical in fostering a sense of belonging, emotional security, and psychological stability among students living away from their families.

CRITERIA FOR T.C.A.A.

- Each subject is of 25 marks.
- Question paper is MCQ based.
- In case of poor performance, we will conduct an interview test of the child within 5 days.
- Two years report grade card should be submitted before Interview.


