The students from Tula's International School were taken to Dubai for an educational tour.

To generate environmental consciences among students, the day commenced with a tree plantation drive. Taking the day forward, a yoga session was also organised. The school participated in the session with keen interest.


The events of the school were presided over by Regional Officer CBSE Ranbir Singh, Principal Shaline Singh and Director Tula's International School Raunak Jain.
